

# Work With Us

If you're interested in working for Baffin Fisheries and have the required training, the next step is to apply. If you don't, you'll need to enroll for training at the Nunavut Fisheries and Marine Training Consortium.

## FACTORY WORKER

Duties include, but are not limited to:

- Take instructions and supervision from the Factory Boss / Assistant Factory Boss
- Responsible for safely operating various fish processing factory equipment, such as fish header machine, grader machine, cookers, plate freezers and conveyors
- Responsible for the processing, weighing, packing and labelling of processed fish products
- Loading and unloading of the product in freezers, (repetitive lifting — must be capable of lifting up to 50 pounds)
- Participate in factory clean up as needed throughout the trip and at the end of trip
- Participate / assist the engineering staff with repairs of equipment
- Participate in required safety drills and training; and actively participate in safety meetings
- Ability to learn and demonstrate understanding of Baffin Fisheries quality assurance standards and operate within these standards to guarantee the highest quality of product produced onboard the vessel
- Acknowledge and follow company and vessel rules pertaining to health and safety programs.
- Perform other duties as assigned

## General Information

- Work rotation is 2 trips on and 2 trips off (approximately 30 days per trip x 2 = 60 days)
- Must be physically fit and capable of working in fast paced harsh environment
- Shifts onboard the vessel are 6 hours on and 6 hours off

## Candidates Must Hold the Following Qualifications

- Valid Transport Canada Marine Medical Certificate
- Valid Marine Emergency Duties STCW Basic Safety (or minimum MED A1 or DVS)
- Valid Passport
- Preference will be given to individuals with Bridge Watch Certificate
